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Treatment Algorithm. The proposed CUR Treatment Algorithm is predicated on stratifying CUR patients first by risk and then by symptoms. All patients with urinary retention should undergo a thorough history and physical examination, including an exam of genitals and rectum, as multiple medical conditions can present with CUR, including pelvic malignancies in both males and females.
